

NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

- A. **The Club collects subscriptions by Direct Debit.** A completed Direct Debit Instruction (forms obtainable from Reception) must be sent with your Membership Application. Members who pay annual subscriptions totalling more than £120.00 on behalf of their families may pay the amount due in five monthly instalments commencing on 1st April. If an application is received later than this date the collection will commence as soon as possible after the Bank has recorded the Direct Debit instruction.
- B. Junior applicants should show this Application Form to their parents who are required to countersign the form and to complete the Direct Debit Instruction.
- C. The Club's membership records are held on computer and used for the collection of subscriptions and for the distribution of Club information to Members. The data is otherwise used solely for internal Club purposes. In order for the Club to be exempt from the Data Protection Act, each Member has to be given the opportunity to object to the retention and use of their personal data in this way.
- D. Charges are made for Junior Member's coaching, group and squad fees, match fees, court fees and tennis court lights. Details are available from Reception.

RULES FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP IS ONLY AVAILABLE FOR THE PLAYING OF SPORT (EXCEPT IN EXCEPTIONAL CASES APPROVED BY THE GENERAL COMMITTEE). PURELY SOCIAL JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP IS NOT AVAILABLE.

As a Junior Member you may:

- Take part in all sports available at the Club – Tennis, Short Tennis, Squash, Racketball, Cricket (from age 8), Table Tennis and Hockey (from age 15).
- Watch all sporting activities taking place at the Club.
- Use the cricket nets (for proper cricket practise only) when supervised by an authorised adult Member.
- Purchase soft drinks, sweets and snacks from Reception (taking care to place **all** litter in the bins provided).
- Go in the bar (but not purchase or consume alcoholic drinks) **but only when with an adult Member.**

As a Junior Member you must NOT:

- Bring non-member guests to the Club except to play sport when the proper Visitor's Fee must be paid first at Reception.
- Use the Clubhouse or Club grounds just as a meeting place for friends with no specific sporting activity in mind.
- Drop or leave litter anywhere in the Clubhouse or grounds.
- Play football **anywhere** in the Clubhouse or on the Club grounds.
- Use the Main Hall except for authorised supervised activity.
- Play in corridors, changing rooms, balconies, squash courts, tennis courts or on the cricket sight screens (this is dangerous and accidents have happened).
- Play in the copse or trample on the flowers.
- Damage any part of the Club or Club equipment.
- Drink alcohol or smoke.

The Rules of the Club are set out in the Club Handbook and added to in some Sections' specific Code of Conduct. Information on activities at the Club is available at Reception and from periodic mailings to Members. **Junior Members are required to have their Membership Cards with them at all times when at the Club. They will be asked to leave if they cannot produce them when requested.**
